ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NONPROFIT CORPORATION
OF
ORCAS CENTER

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME, STATUS AND FUNCTION SECRETARY OF STATE

The Orcas Center hereby elects to be organized under the provision of RCW 24.03 as a nonprofit organization. The corporation's principal function will be to construct and/or maintain and/or operate a community center building for the benefit of the residents of Orcas Island and any other functions approved by the Board of Directors consistent with this goal.

ARTICLE II. PERIOD OF DURATION/RESTRICTIONS ON PROFIT

The corporation shall exist until it is dissolved by two-thirds of the directors present at a special meeting called for that purpose or by a vote of 40% of the membership of the corporation at a special meeting called for that purpose.

All corporate assets, upon dissolution, will be turned over to a public entity or another nonprofit corporation with similar aims and no private person shall receive any portion of the corporation's assets except as compensation for goods or services provided to the corporation, which compensation shall be approved in advance by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE III. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION/BYLAWS

The Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws may be amended by a vote of two-thirds of those directors presents at any regular or special meeting.

ARTICLE IV. MEMBERSHIP/ORGANIZATION

The corporation shall extend membership to those

persons willing to participate in and contribute their time and efforts to the development and betterment of the community center and who are approved for membership by the Board of Directors of the corporation and who pay the membership fee, if any, set by the Board of Directors and abide by the corporate bylaws as the same are adopted or amended by the membership and ratified by the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting. The directors shall number no less than five (5) and no more than nine (9), as determined by the membership, and shall be elected annually by the members or as vacancies occur by the remaining directors. The directors shall select the corporate officers to serve at the directors' pleasure.

ARTICLE V.

The corporation shall operate on a fiscal year beginning January 1st and ending December 31 of each year.

ARTICLE VI. REGISTERED AGENT/DIRECTORS

The registered agent of the corporation shall be MARGARET EXTON and its agents office shall be Box 36, Orcas, Washington 98280.
